



Move-In Checklist

Necessary Items

- Bath robe, shower shoes
- Shower Caddy
- Towels and Washcloths
- Twin-Sized Bedding (Comforter, sheets, pillowcases, blanket, mattress pad, etc. **Guys** - Some rooms in Tom Black Hall have *extra long* twin beds.)
- Alarm Clock
- Power Strips/ 3-Prong Adaptors
- Outdoor Approved Extension Cord
- Laundry Items (Detergent, Laundry Hamper, quarters for the machines, etc.)
- Emergency Kit (First Aid Kit, Batteries, Bottled Water, Flashlight, etc.)
- Paper Towels/Kleenex
- Clothes Hangers
- Room decorations, pictures of family and friends

Suggested Items

- Extra twin-sized mattress (this will make your bed higher)

Items to Leave at Home

- Hot Plates, Slot Toasters, or Other Fire Hazards
- Halogen Lamps
- Alcohol
- Weapons (Including air pellet, soft pellet, water, paintball, or BB guns; swords;knives; etc.)

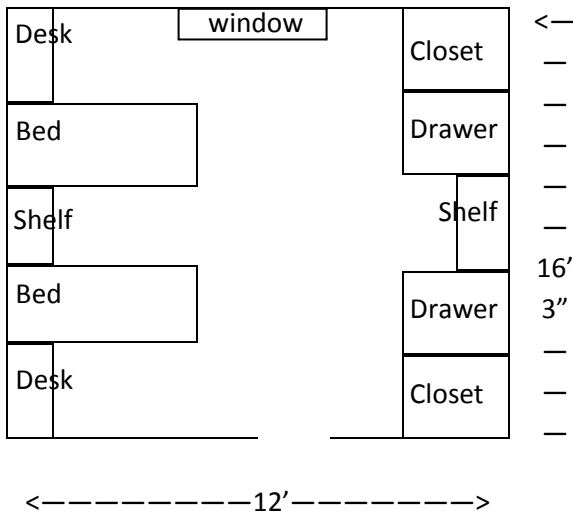

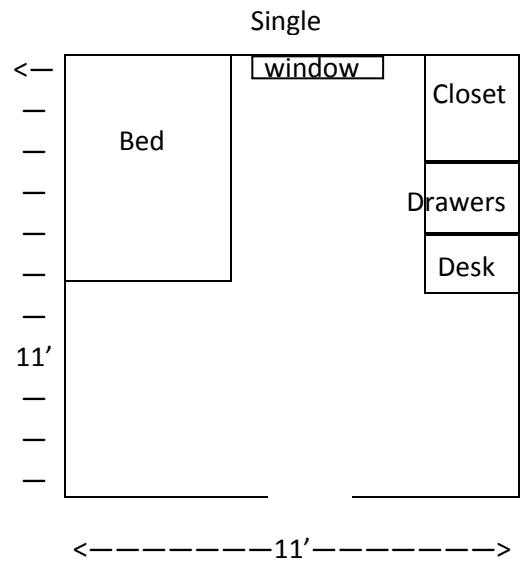
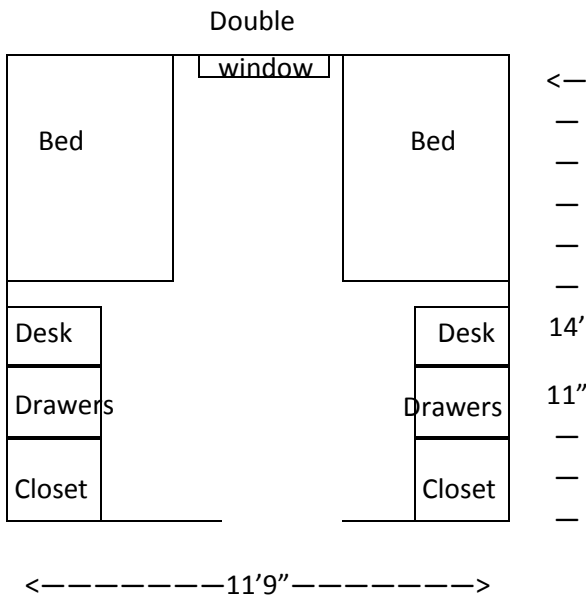
